Who is eligible in the ‘youth’ category to complete the survey?

A youth or former youth (any age) who is receiving, or has received in the past, services from a children’s aid society or who was provided with licensed residential services



If I do not have a computer, where can I use one to complete the survey?

Suggestions: public libraries, high school computer labs, university/college campus, YMCA and other community centers, Employment Ontario, drop-in centers, shelters



If I do not have wi-fi, where can I find free access to complete the survey?

Suggestions: public libraries, subway stations, malls, cafes and restaurants (such as McDonalds, Starbucks, and Tim Hortons), Telus Mobility for Good Program
